Sessions are held in Fall, Winter, and Spring

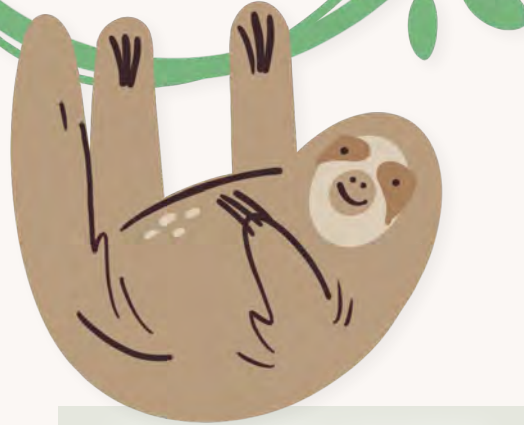
Tuition: \$50-60 per Session, based on session length

MISSION

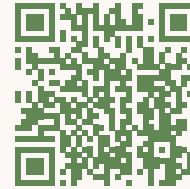
The mission of the preschool is to help children develop spiritually, intellectually and physically in a Christian environment.

TUITION \$2,003 per year. \$75 nonrefundable registration fee. Three installments of \$667.67 each due Aug. 15, Nov. 15, and Feb. 15. A one-time supply fee of \$30 is also due on Aug. 15.
